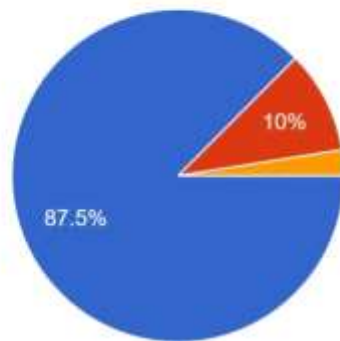

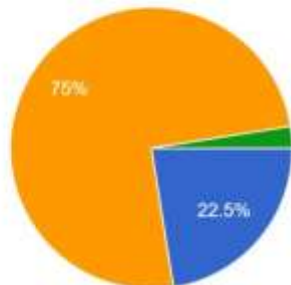

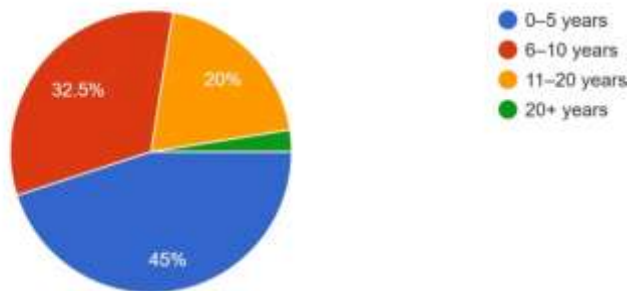


3. How many years have you followed or played cricket?

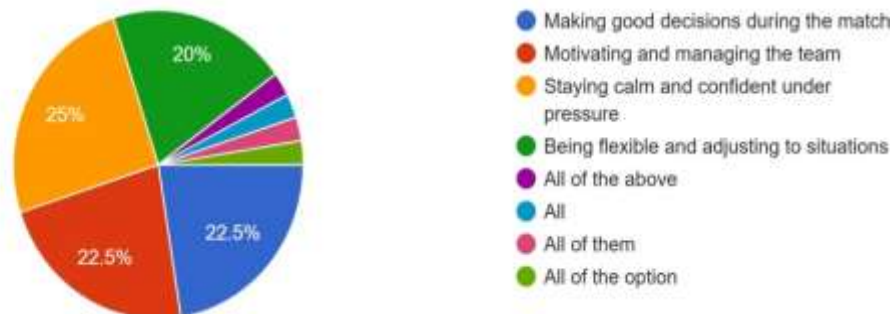


4. What do you think is the most important quality for a cricket captain?

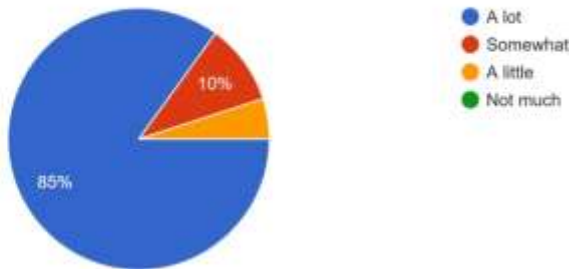


5. How much do you think a captain affects a team's success?

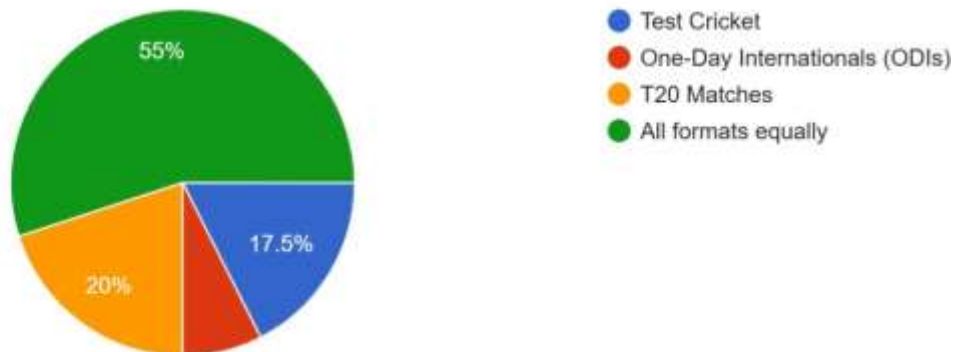


6. Which format of cricket do you think needs the best captaincy?

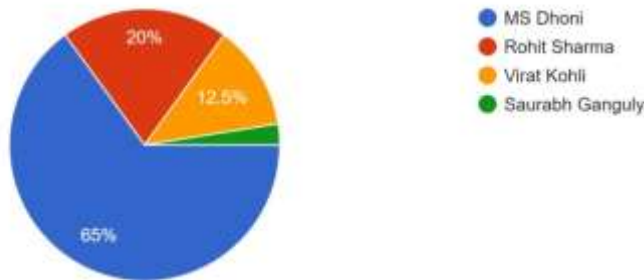


7. Who do you think is the best captain between 2000 and 2024?

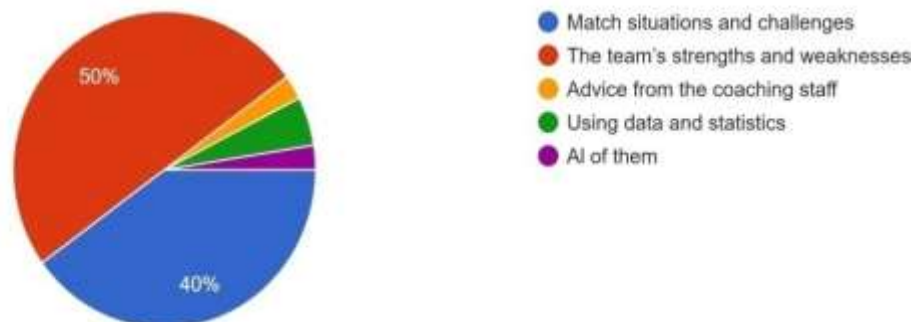


8. What do you think helps a captain make good decisions? (Choose the most important one)

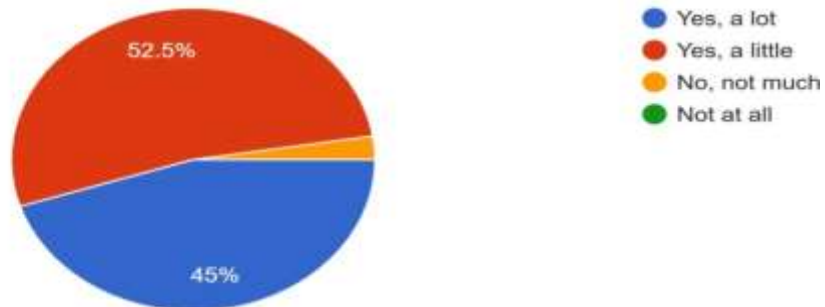


9. Do you think technology and statistics help captains lead better?

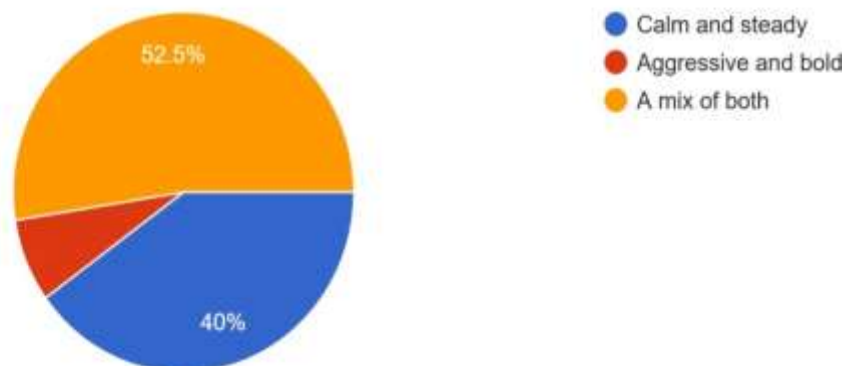


10. What kind of captain do you think works better?
